The Worrall and Fuller Exhibition Fund (Charity number 312507) is seeking to recruit two additional members to its Board of Governors.

Dating back to 1689, we are a small charity that supports the education and training of children and young people who live in, study in or have parents working in, the southern part of Islington – the former London Borough of Finsbury. We make grants, ranging from about £250 to £750 each, to around 25 to 30 children and young people each year for educational and vocational purposes. Our current priorities are to help meet the costs of extra-curricular, non-mainstream education and organised out-of-school activities.

During the next two years we anticipate both a substantial increase in applications for grants and a considerable expansion of the charity's financial resources. We are looking for one or more new Governors to help devise a strategy to prepare the Fund for an exciting new future.

Ideally, you would

- Have experience of investment and financial management, especially in the not-for-profit sector.
- Be living in our area of operation, or have other connections with it.
- Be able to attend at least two Board meetings a year and available from time to time for other consultations.

The Governors' positions are unpaid.
